More space for bus maintenance with easier and safer access to fueling stations

Zero net energy photovoltaic system

Environmentally sustainable materials using LEED principles

NVRTA will build a new maintenance and administration facility to address the growing needs of the transit operations. The current facility is ill-equipped to handle the existing needs and future growth. The project will allow NVRTA to maintain and expand transit service for the next 50 years.
