The City Council hereby determines and certifies that: (a) the Maintenance of Effort ("MOE") for the City of Napa for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 is \$4,233,669.18 as described on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; (b) for each of the past three Fiscal Years (2019/20, 2020/21, and 2021/22), the City of Napa met and exceeded its obligation for an MOE of at least \$3,383,221.35, as set forth in R2018-007; and (c) the City of Napa will meet its MOE obligation of at least \$3,383,221.35 for Fiscal Years 2022/2023 and 2023/2024.

4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




