

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

MAY 2023



The following is a general summary of activity at Napa Valley Transportation Authority and Vine Transit:



Bike-to-Wherever Day is May 18! NVTA will be hosting an energizer station adjacent to Vine Trail just south of Vallejo on Soscol Avenue between 7:00 - 9:30 a.m. We invite all of our board members and the public to ride by and say hello.

The public is invited to take a traffic safety survey as part of the Vision Zero effort to eliminate traffic deaths and severe injuries on our roadways. The survey is located on NVTA's website – under vision zero survey – and will be open until June 1. Additionally, there is an interactive map where members of the public can highlight areas where there is excessive speeding or other traffic violations and where improvements can be made.



CalSTA listening session – NVTA staff participate in the CalSTA listening session about the public transit fiscal cliff which was held at MTC on Tuesday, May 9. In addition, Secretary Toks Omishaken and other CalSTA staff participated and heard about the ongoing challenges of northern California operators and proposed policy solutions to help improve transit in California.

Climate Action Now in coordination with St. Helena council member Anna Chouteau and Napa Vice Mayor, Beth Painter, is holding the first Climate Action Summit on May 24 at NVC. NVTA staff have been invited to participate.

NVTA Principal Planner Diana Meehan served as a panelist focusing on Vision Zero on the Institute of Transportation Engineers webinar entitled Safe Systems Approach.

NVTA Marketing and Public Communications Staff, Valerie Walston tabling at the Rohlffs Manor Resource Fair on June 9 from 10am – 1pm. Valerie will be sharing about transportation options and resources for seniors, including Taxi Scrip, VineGo, and Clipper discount information.
