PROJECT SUMMARY

Grant Funding

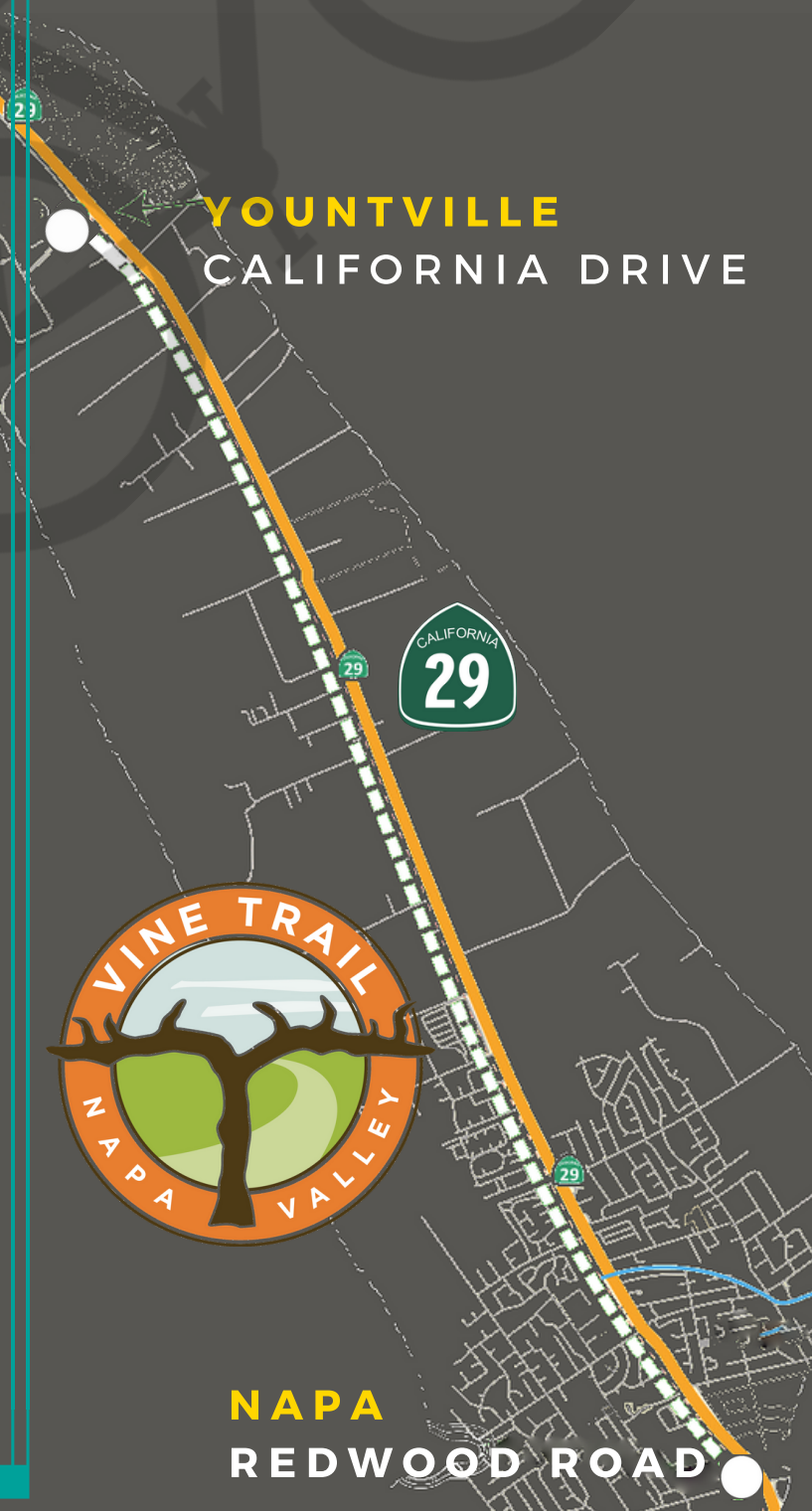
NVTA secured nearly **\$7 million** in state and federal funds for the 6-mile stretch of Vine Trail linking Napa to Yountville along Solano Avenue, a project totaling about **\$10 million**. NVTA is project sponsor for the Oak Knoll segment, a unique collaboration between the private Napa Valley Vine Trail Coalition, local agencies and Caltrans.

12.5 miles

With the Oak Knoll Segment finished, 12.5 miles of Class I paths are now available for bicyclists & pedestrians to travel safely between Napa and Yountville. When complete, the Vine Trail will be a **47-mile** path linking the Napa Valley from Calistoga to the Vallejo Ferry Terminal.

What's next?

Plans for a segment of Vine Trail between Calistoga and St. Helena are underway after NVTA and the Vine Trail Coalition secured a **\$6.1 million** state grant. Construction could begin in 2019.

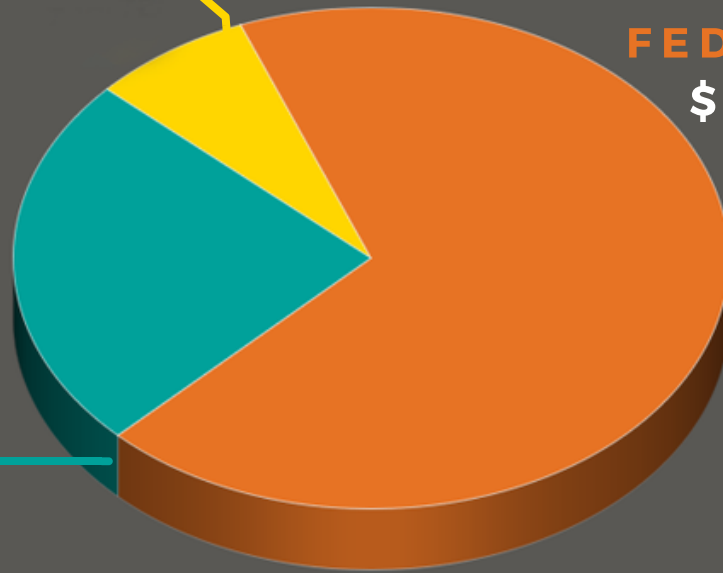
